

Registration

Anyone 18 years of age or older with a high school diploma or a GED is eligible to register. Registration is available at ETI Technical College in the Main Office by appointment. Any person registering for the Nurse Aide Training is required by the state of Ohio to have a negative Mantoux (TB) test result or chest X-ray from your physician or local health department.

These results and a clean state background check are required in order to attend your clinical hours.

Objectives and Goals

During training, nurse aides will receive the information necessary for safe, effective, and respectful care as outlined by the training requirements by the OBRA Act of 1987.

ETI's comprehensive training program, taught by Registered Nurses, can significantly improve the lives of those individuals who complete the training by giving them a competitive advantage. With an emphasis on academics and hands-on skills training, graduates of the program are well prepared for the requirements to pass the state test as well as to be successfully employed in the health care field.

What is a Nurse Aide?

A Nurse Aide is a person who assists individuals with healthcare needs or activities of daily living. A Nurse Aide also provides bedside care, including basic nursing procedures under the supervision of a Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse usually in a hospital, nursing home, or an assisted living facility.

ETI Technical College offers State of Ohio Department of Health approved training. Upon successful completion you will be eligible to take the State Test to become a State Tested Nurse Aide (STNA). We are also an approved testing site, so it is possible to take state test on the same equipment you train on at ETI Technical College.
