The Full-Time ADN-RN program is available two ways; an Advanced standing option for LPN's and a complete program for new students. Classes begins September 14, 2020 and are available both day and night. NOW is the time to start preparing to be a Registered Nurse! These classes are limited so don't delay in getting started.

Here is a list of "Things to Do"

1. Meet with Admissions, if you have not done so already call 330-652-9919
2. Have OFFICIAL High School or GED transcripts sent NOT faxed to ETI
3. Have OFFICIAL College and or Technical school transcripts sent to ETI
4. Do 2020-2021 FAFSA (Fin Aid can assist you with this)
5. Free Review classes when you purchase the \$45 Review book.
6. Take/Pass Evolve Hesi Exam-You must have 75% in Reading, Grammar and Math (call for test dates). Free Pre-test available
7. Meet with Financial Aid and bring in Dr. License or State ID and any other documents requested
8. Complete your BCI/FBI background checks, no consideration will be made without (must be mailed to ETI)
9. Keep in touch with Admissions

After all this is completed, the Director of Nursing will contact you for an advisement meeting, please remember this is an interview.

If you have any questions, please give me a call 330-299-7190 and I will be happy to help you get started. I do suggest you double check that your transcripts and BCI/FBI background checks were received by ETI, you will not be considered for this program without them.

To be considered for the Associate Degree of Applied Science in Nursing-ADN or the Practical Nursing program you must take the Hesi exam in Reading, Grammar and Math and score 75% in each section. Applicants can go to: <http://www.test-guide.com> for a FREE review on-line, or stop in and purchase the Hesi Admission Assessment Exam, Edition 4, Review book for \$45.00.

If you purchase the book from ETI you can sign up for FREE review classes held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm OR 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. The HESI exam consists of a total of 10 different exams, however ETI only tests these (3) areas:

- **Math – 50 question exam with 50 minute time limit. Evaluates a student’s math skills as related to health care. Math skills that are tested include: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, ratios, proportions, fractions and decimals. A large portion of the exam will include conversions, household measures and dosage calculations.**
- **Reading – 47 question exam with 60 minute time limit. The reading comprehension exam will measure a student’s capability to understand reading passages. These reading passages will typically be health care related. Students will be required to identify a primary theme, find the meaning of phrases in context, determine logical inferences and understand reading passages.**
- **Grammar – 50 question exam with 50 minute time limit. Basic grammar principles are evaluated. These include important terms, their uses in grammar, common grammatical errors, and parts of speech.**

To register for the Hesi Exam a non-refundable test fee of \$50.00, must be paid at least one week prior to your test date at the front desk, in the Administration Office at ETI. Applicants who do not pass the test are permitted (1) Free re-test. Test results are good for (1) year. Please check with admissions for HESI test dates.

PN applicant ONLY- a 3rd test is permitted if: after your second attempt, you passed 2 areas and failed one area with a score between 70% - 74%, this will be at an additional fee of \$50.00. Test results are good for (1) year.
